Clothe a Child – In In September 2009, my family with other 8 people from the US, visited Manna Center in Romania (see our newsletter Sep-Oct 2010). This trip influenced all of us, especially Ashley. Ashley, who is our youngest daughter, returned home with a great burden for the children she met. For weeks she pondered how she could help them. During our own missions conference in November 2009, the Holy Spirit led her to coordinate a "mini" ministry for the children in Romania. With another Christian friend, Simona, they started a collection for children's clothing. Their goal is to:

- 1, help children in need,
- 2, organize youth trips to Hungary/Romania for our young people (churched and unchurched)
- 3, minister children in Hungary/Romania
- 4, share gospel with those (in Slovakia) who donate the clothing

By now, the response has been overwhelming. It is not just the quantity but also the quality of the clothing. 90% of the clothing is worn very little and some pieces still have price tags. All clothing is clean, washed, ironed, and folded – much better looking then in "Thrift store", "Salvation Army", or "Second hand store".

I trust, this efforts will bring blessings to those whom we desire to minister.

Many thanks to Bro. Walter Stevens, missionary to Gypsies in Hungary and Romania, who plays a vital role in this endeavour.
