



## MMKP Continues to Transform Our Churches!

We have just wrapped up our Meet My Kaibigan (friend) Parties. These parties prove to be a highly effective evangelistic tool. It's simply designed to have your friends, who you would classify as receptive to the gospel, attend a party. We have games, goodies, and the gospel. **This year through our network of 14 church plants we saw Total guests: 2,229. Saved: 1,503. That is 67.43% of every guest attending a MMKP was saved.**

God is good. We followed the MMKPs with a celebration party for all the small group leaders, small group assistants and interns. 274 showed up for the celebration. We look forward to see how God will use our small group based, Non-Facility dependant model to continue to start new churches.

As part of our discipleship and training of new believers we follow up and discuss the importance of baptism. **A few Sundays ago I was able to assist in the baptism of 40 people, many of who were saved during our MMKP (Meet My Kaibigan/Friend Parties) season.**

Watching young men, boys, girls, young women and matured adults all make public professions of their Faith in Jesus Christ really was inspiring. Some of these newly baptized had been saved for years and never publicly displayed it through baptism while others had not even been saved more than a month. God's hand continues to move and show us that He is doing great things in the Philippines.
